All the fall beets and carrots that Cody seeded last week have popped up this week. We also had the first garlic harvest, and now there are bins and bins of garlic drying in the greenhouse. Needless to say, it now smells great in the greenhouse.

Some of the sweet corn is beginning to mature, and hopefully it is coming soon to the CSA shares! One of the varieties, pictured to the right, has wonderful, red silk that adds vibrant color to the rows of sweet corn.

A couple weeks ago, Matt had noticed a visitor outside the greenhouse. A large, brightly colored, swallowtail caterpillar was hanging out (pictured below). This past week, we noticed a large, also vividly colored, butterfly visiting the greenhouse (also pictured below). It turned out to be a black swallowtail butterfly, perhaps returning to visit where it spent its caterpillar youth!
