### News from the Farm

The pattern of hot, sunny days continued over these past two weeks. Some of the plants love this, but others, such as lettuce and cauliflower, prefer a bit cooler shade. We break one of the cauliflower's leaves over the head of cauliflower to help it maintain its whiteness. If left to the sun, the heads will turn a dull yellow.

These past two weeks we also planted all the fall brassicas. This includes broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage, and kohlrabi. We also harvested the first cherry tomatoes—the sun golds pictured to left. And the sweet corn has begun to tassel. The tassels are the male part of the corn that produce the pollen for the plant. Eventually, pollination will occur when pollen grains are transferred from the tassel to the silks. Each kernel on the ear has its own silk strand, which must be pollinated to produce edible sweet corn.
